

Sallisaw Public Schools Bullying/Intimidation/Harassment Policy

Bullying is defined as a pattern of harassment, intimidation, threatening behavior, physical acts, verbal or electronic, directed toward a student or group of students that results in or is reasonably perceived as being done with the intent to cause negative educational or physical results for the targeted individual or group and is communicated in such a way as to disrupt or interfere with the school's educational mission or the education of any student.

The Sallisaw Public Schools' student conduct code prohibits harassment, intimidation, and bullying. The matter should be reported to the building principal who will investigate the report and determine if the school discipline code was violated. If it is determined that the school district's discipline code has been violated or a disruption to the educational process, the building principal shall follow the district policies regarding the discipline of the student.
