Sallisaw Public Schools has chosen the ACT as a locally selected, nationally recognized high school assessment tool which incorporates into the College and Career Readiness Assessment Selection processes per Oklahoma State Department of Education. All students enrolled in the 11th grade at Sallisaw High School, will be required to take the ACT for district and state graduation requirements. Sallisaw Public Schools has vertically aligned curriculum and ACT standards beginning in 6th grade and continuing through 12th grade. Students participate in quarterly ACT Aspire assessments in order to evaluate achievement and progress necessary to meet or exceed benchmark requirements.
